Royal Burgundy Barberry

Berberis thunbergii 'Gentry'

Deep purple foliage all summer long. Yellow flowers in early spring. Red berries in winter. Grows 2ft high & 3ft wide.

Rose Glow Barberry

Berberis thunbergii 'Rose Glow'

Pink and purple variegated foliage. Yellow flowers in early spring. Red berries in winter. Grows 3ft high & 4ft wide.

Ruby Carousel Barberry

Berberis thunbergii 'Ruby Carousel'

Deep brick red foliage that turns bright red in fall. Yellow flowers in early spring. Red berries in winter. Matures at 3ft high & 3ft wide.

Jade Carousel Barberry

Smokebush ○

Waxy purple leaves with plume of smokey purple flowers. Matures at 12 - 15ft high & 8ft wide.

Golden Spirit Smokebush

Cotinus coggygria 'Golden Spirit'

Its spring foliage ranges from lime green to brilliant gold then followed by fall colors in shades of coral, orange and red. Light pink flowers. Matures at 4-5 ft high & wide.

Young Lady Smokebush

Cotinus coggygria 'Young Lady'

Frothy pink blooms cover every inch of this plant in early summer. Green leaves with yellow in fall. Matures at 4 - 6ft high & wide.

Dogwoods



Dogwoods are a very tough and forgiving plant. They can be used in the dry or the wet areas of your garden. Dogwoods will also grow in full sun or partial shade. They are attractive all year round with their clusters of flowers, various foliage colors, and unique bark colors.

Attracts birds.

Zone 2 to 3.

Silver Variegated Dogwood

Cornus alba 'Elagantissima'

Green and white variegated leaves all season with red stems. Excellent winter effect. Matures at 9ft high & 6ft wide.

Bailey's Redtwig Dogwood

Cornus baileyi

Green leaves that turn brick red in fall. Creamy white flowers in spring followed by blue berries. Matures at 10ft high & wide.

Ivory Halo Dogwood

Cornus alba 'Bailhalo'

A compact and very hardy shrub. Variegated green and white leaves with red bark. Matures at 6ft high & 5ft wide.

Siberian Pearls Dogwood

Cornus alba 'Siberian Pearls'

A smaller version of the Siberian dogwood. Green leaves, red fall color. White berries that turn blue in fall. Matures at 7ft high & 6ft wide.

Golden Variegated Dogwood

Cornus alba 'Gouchaulti'

Green and gold variegated foliage all season, Red stems that make an excellent winter effect. Matures at 7ft high & wide.

Siberian Dogwood

Cornus alba 'Siberica'

Brilliant, florescent red stems. Green foliage that turns deep red in fall. Creamy white flowers followed by white berries. Matures at 9ft high & wide.

Bud's Yellowtwig Dogwood

Cornus alba 'Bud's Yellow'

Green leaves that turn yellow in the fall. Brilliant yellow stems. Creamy white flowers in spring. Matures at 8ft high & wide.

Morden Amber Dogwood

Cornus alba 'Morden Amber'

Chartreuse green leaves all summer turning red in fall. Bright red stems. White flowers in spring followed by white berries. Matures at 5ft high & 6ft wide.

Pagoda Dogwood

Cornus alternifolia

Horizontal branching habit. Green leaves, red fall color. White flowers, blue berries. Matures at 20ft high & wide.

Euonymus



This shrub performs well in both full sun and full shade. It is very adaptable to both dry and moist locations. Excellent fall and fruit color. Zone 2-3

Turkestan Euonymus

Euonymus nanus 'Turkestanicus'

Narrow green semi-evergreen leaves all season turning scarlet red in fall. Hot pink seed pods in late summer. Matures at 3ft high & wide.

Hydrangea

There are three main types of hydrangea grown in Manitoba. They are the Mophead & Lacecap Type, Pee Gee Type and the Annabelle Type. All groups are a wonderful addition to any landscape with their late summer to fall blooming period.

Mophead & Lacecap Types ○●

Mophead and lacecaps have thick green leaves with round flower heads that tend to be blue or pink. They require a sheltered location and full sun to part. Prune in early spring.

Endless Summer Hydrangea

Hydrangea macrophylla 'Bailmer'

Mop-head type hydrangea with the unique ability to bloom consistently on both old and new wood. Pink blooms in alkaline soils and blue blooms in acidic soil. Matures at 3-5ft high & wide.

Blushing Bride Hydrangea

Hydrangea macrophylla 'Blushing Bride'

Pure white blooms with semi-double florets gradually mature to a sweet, pink blush. The disease and mildew-resistant foliage is an attractive dark green. Matures at 4-5ft high & wide.

Twist and Shout Hydrangea

Hydrangea macrophylla 'PIIHM-I'

Pure white blooms with semi-double florets gradually mature to a sweet, pink blush. The disease and mildew-resistant foliage is an attractive dark green. Matures at 4-5ft high & wide.

Paniculata Type ○●●

Paniculata type Hydrangeas are a hardy group that can tolerate drier conditions than the other types. They have large cone shaped flowers ranging from white to pink. Prune in late fall or early spring.

Pee Gee Hydrangea

Hydrangea paniculata 'Grandiflora'

Bold conical white flowers with rose overtones at the ends of the branches from midsummer to late fall. Matures at 7-8ft high & wide.

Quick Fire Hydrangea

Hydrangea paniculata Quick Fire'

Blooms up to a month earlier than other hydrangeas! White flowers change to pink. Blooms every year. Easy to grow. Matures at 4-5 ft high & wide.

Pinky Winky Hydrangea

Hydrangea paniculata 'Pinky Winky'

Extremely large, cone shaped flowers that start off white and turn deep pink at the base. Very hardy. Matures at 6-8 ft high & wide.

Bombshell Hydrangea

Hydrangea paniculata 'Bombshell'

With a dwarf growth habit, 'Bombshell' is incredibly well branched. Covered in white flowers against dark green foliage from early Summer until frost. Matures at 2 - 3ft high & 3-4ft wide.

Hydrangea paniculata 'Kyushu'

White cone shaped flowers in late summer, turning pink as the fall approaches. Flowers very well in the shade. Matures at 6 -8 ft high & wide.

Masses of pure white flowers begin flowering in mid to late summer. Blooms every year. Hardy. Excellent for fall and winter effect. Matures at 4-5ft high & wide.

Features bold balls of white flowers at the ends of the branches from mid to late summer. The flowers are excellent for cutting. Matures at 4 ft high and 5 ft wide.

Seabuckthorn ○

This attractive small tree or shrub has narrow silver leaves. Plentiful round yellow orange fruits cover the female plants making them beautiful edible ornamentals. You need male plants to pollinate the female. The fruits are valued for their high content of vitamin C and anti antioxidants.

Male

Required for fruit production. Large upright plant with narrow silvery green foliage which adds texture to landscape. 2-3 ft

Mock Orange ○

Mock Orange has sweet smelling blooms in June. They are excellent as an accent or screen. Pruning is to be done after they flower. Zone 2-3.

Blizzard Mock Orange

Philadelphus lewisii 'Blizzard'
Covered in clusters of fragrant white flowers with yellow eyes at the ends of the branches in late spring. It has green foliage throughout the season. Matures at 8ft high & wide.

Snowbelle Mock Orange

Philadelphus 'Snowbelle'
Compact growing mock orange with masses of double white flowers. Green leaves. Matures at 4ft high & wide.

Golden Mock Orange

Philadelphus coronarius 'Aureus'
Beautiful and versatile shrub featuring rich golden foliage and fragrant white flowers in early summer. Matures at 7ft high & wide.

A tidy, ball-shaped and mounded shrub which features pale yellow flowers in spring and red berries in fall. Very hardy. Matures at 3ft high & 4ft wide.

Foliage emerges a wine-red and fades to reddish-purple, setting apart the showy white flowers in spring. More compact maturing at 5ft high & wide.

Center Glow Ninebark

Physocarpus opulifolius 'Center Glow'
Foliage starts bicoloured yellow-green and burgundy then settles to a distinctively rich red, which shows the white flower clusters very well. Matures at 6ft high & wide.

Coppertina Ninebark

Physocarpus opulifolius 'Mindia'
Has coppery-orange-red new foliage in spring that fades to a dark reddish-purple. White flowers. Matures at 7ft high & wide.

Dart's Gold Ninebark

Physocarpus opulifolius 'Dart's Gold'
Showy golden yellow foliage all season. White flowers in summer followed by red fruits. Matures at 5ft high & wide.

Common Ninebark

Physocarpus opulifolius
Bright green leaves all season that turn a beautiful orange in fall. White flowers. Makes an excellent hedge. Matures at 8ft by 8ft.high & wide.

Potentilla flower from June to frost. They come in yellows, oranges, whites and pinks. Very hardy. Attracts butterflies and is deer resistant. Prune yearly. Zone 2.

Coronation Triumph Potentilla

Potentilla fruticosa 'Coronation Triumph'
Bright yellow flowers. Matures at 4ft high & 3ft wide.

Goldfinger Potentilla

Potentilla fruticosa 'Goldfinger'
Large golden yellow flowers. Matures at 3ft high & 4ft wide.

Goldstar Potentilla

Potentilla fruticosa 'Goldstar'
Grey green foliage with large golden yellow. Matures at 3 ft high and 4ft wide.

Yellowbird Potentilla

Potentilla fruticosa 'Yellowbird'
Bright gold, double flowers June to frost. Matures at 3ft high & 4ft wide.

Yellow Gem Potentilla

Potentilla fruticosa 'Yellow Gem'
Bright yellow flowers from June to frost with grey green foliage. Matures at 24" high & 3ft wide.

Abbottswood Potentilla

Potentilla fruticosa 'Abbottswood'
Compact shrub covered in white flowers from June to frost. Matures at 3ft high & wide.

McKay's White Potentilla

Potentilla fruticosa 'McKay's White'
Compact ball shaped shrub with white flowers from June to frost. Matures at 2ft high & wide.

Snowbird Potentilla

Potentilla fruticosa 'Snowbird'
Deep green foliage with double white flowers from June to frost. Matures at 3ft high & wide.

Pink Beauty Potentilla

Potentilla fruticosa 'Pink Beauty'
Tight growing deep green leaves with pink flowers from June to frost. Matures at 30" high & 3ft wide.

Mango Tango Potentilla

Potentilla fruticosa 'Mango Tango'
Showy yellow flowers that are streaked with orange. Compact growth, Matures at 2ft high & wide.

Masses of dark mauve flowers in spring. Compact shrub maturing at 2ft high & wide.

Golden Lights Azalea

Rhododendron x 'Golden Lights'
Deep golden yellow blooms in spring. Matures at 5ft high & wide.

Lilac Lights Azalea

Rhododendron x 'Lilac Lights'
Lilac purple flowers in early spring. Matures at 4ft high & wide.

Lemon Lights Azalea

Rhododendron x 'Lemon Lights'
Light yellow flowers in early spring. Matures at 3ft high & 4ft wide.

Mandarin Lights Azalea

Rhododendron x 'Mandarin Lights'
Deep orange flowers in early spring. Matures at 3ft high & 4ft wide.

Northern Hi-Lights Azalea

Rhododendron x 'Northern Hi Lights'
Creamy white flowers with yellow accents. Matures at 4ft high & 5ft wide.

Cutleaf Staghorn Sumac

Rhus typhina 'Lanciniata'
Very large shrub with large toothed leaves that turn scarlet red orange in fall. Spiked yellow flowers in summer and crimson fruit that stay through the winter. Matures at 15 ft high & wide.

Tiger Eye Sumac

Rhus typhina 'Baltiger'
Finely cut tropical-looking foliage which emerges chartreuse turning bright gold all season, with fabulous yellow, orange and scarlet fall color. Matures at 6ft high & wide.

They are not good in areas that will be hot and sunny during the winter months. This will cause winter burning. Plants in this type of location will have to be covered with burlap for the winter.
