Green leaves that turn fire red and orange in fall. Yellow flowers in early spring. Red berries in winter. Matures at 3ft high & 4ft wide.

### Sunsation Barberry

*Berberis thunbergii 'Aurea nana'*

Bright yellow foliage that turns orange in fall. Grows 3ft high & 4ft wide.

### Concorde Barberry

*Berberis Thunbergii*

Rounded shape with deep burgundy purple foliage that turns slightly reddish in the fall. Grows 18" high & wide.

Frothy pink blooms cover every inch of this plant in early summer. Green leaves with yellow in fall. Matures at 4 - 6ft high & wide.

## Dogwoods



Dogwoods are a very tough and forgiving plant. They can be used in the dry or the wet areas of your garden. Dogwoods will also grow in full sun or partial shade. They are attractive all year round with their clusters of flowers, various foliage colors, and unique bark colors. Attracts birds.

Zone 2 to 3.

### Ivory Halo Dogwood

*Cornus alba 'Bailhalo'*

A compact and very hardy shrub. Variegated green and white leaves with red bark. Matures at 6ft high & 5ft wide.

### Silver Variegated Dogwood

*Cornus alba 'Elegantissima'*

Green and white variegated leaves all season with red stems. Excellent winter effect. Matures at 9ft high & 6ft wide.

### Golden Variegated Dogwood

*Cornus alba 'Gouchaulti'*

Green and gold variegated foliage all season, Red stems that make an excellent winter effect. Matures at 7ft high & wide.

### Cracker Cream Dogwood

*Cornus alba 'Cracker Cream'*

Variegated foliage that is a creamy ivory and green, red bark. Matures at 6-8ft high & 4-5ft wide.

### Siberian Pearls Dogwood

*Cornus alba 'Siberian Pearls'*

A smaller version of the Siberian dogwood. Green leaves, red fall color. White berries that turn blue in fall. Matures at 7ft high & 6ft wide.

### Silver Variegated Siberian Dogwood

*Cornus alba sibirica 'Variegata'*

Variegated green and silver foliage but a thicker leaf and brighter red bark similar to the Siberian Dogwood. Matures at 8-10 ft high & wide.

### Red Osier Dogwood

*Cornus stolonifera*

Native to Manitoba. Green leaves, red fall color. White flowers, blue berries. Matures at 10 ft high & wide.

### Kesselring Dogwood

*Cornus alba 'Kesselringii'*

Green leaves that are purple tinged. Dark purple stems. White flowers in spring followed by white berries. Matures at 6ft high & wide.

### Siberian Dogwood

*Cornus alba 'Siberica'*

Brilliant, florescent red stems. Green foliage that turns deep red in fall. Creamy white flowers followed by white berries. Matures at 9ft high & wide.

### Bud's Yellowtwig Dogwood

*Cornus alba 'Bud's Yellow'*

Green leaves that turn yellow in the fall. Brilliant yellow stems. Creamy white flowers in spring. Matures at 8ft high & wide.

### Morden Amber Dogwood

*Cornus alba 'Morden Amber'*

Chartreuse green leaves all summer turning red in fall. Bright red stems. White flowers in spring followed by white berries. Matures at 5ft high & 6ft wide.

### Bailey's Redtwig Dogwood

*Cornus baileyi*

Green leaves that turn brick red in fall. Creamy white flowers in spring followed by blue berries. Matures at 10ft high & wide.

## Hydrangea

There are three main types of hydrangea grown in Manitoba. They are the Mophead & Lacecap Type, Pee Gee Type and the Annabelle Type. All groups are a wonderful addition to any landscape with their late summer to fall blooming period.

### Mophead & Lacecap Types ○●

Mophead and lacecaps have thick green leaves with round flower heads that tend to be blue or pink. They require a sheltered location and full sun to part. Prune in early spring.

#### Endless Summer Hydrangea

*Hydrangea macrophylla 'Bailmer'*

Mop-head type hydrangea with the unique ability to bloom consistently on both old and new wood. Pink blooms in alkaline soils and blue blooms in acidic soil. Matures at 3-5ft high & wide.

#### Summer Crush Hydrangea

*Hydrangea macrophylla 'Bailmer'*

Mop-head type hydrangea with the unique ability to bloom consistently on both old and new wood. Raspberry pink blooms. Matures at 3-5ft high & wide.

#### Bloomstruck Hydrangea

*Hydrangea macrophylla 'Bloomstruck'*

Depending on soil pH, you can have rose-pink, violet or blue flower heads. BloomStruck also has incredibly beautiful red-purple stems, dark green leaves. Matures at 3-4 ft high and wide.

### Paniculata Type ○●●

Paniculata type Hydrangeas are a hardy group that can tolerate drier conditions than the other types. They have large cone shaped flowers ranging from white to pink. Prune in late fall or early spring.

#### Pee Gee Hydrangea

*Hydrangea paniculata 'Grandiflora'*

Bold conical white flowers with rose overtones at the ends of the branches from midsummer to late fall. Matures at 7-8ft high & wide.

#### Pinky Winky Hydrangea

*Hydrangea paniculata 'Pinky Winky'*

Extremely large, cone shaped flowers that start off white and turn deep pink at the base. Very hardy. Matures at 6-8 ft high & wide

#### Fire Light Hydrangea

*Hydrangea paniculata 'Tardiva'*

White summer flowers turn deep pink to red in fall. Very hardy. Matures at 4-5ft high

#### Sweet Summer Hydrangea

*Hydrangea paniculata 'Sweet summer'*

Medium sized plants with masses of green flowers that mature to white in summer then pink in fall. Very sturdy stems

#### Little Quickfire Hydrangea

*Hydrangea paniculata SMHPLQF™*

A dwarf version of the Quickfire. With the same early flowering but in a compact size. Matures at 2.5-3.5ft

#### Quick Fire Hydrangea

*Hydrangea paniculata Quick Fire'*

Blooms up to a month earlier than other hydrangeas! White flowers change to pink. Matures at 4-5 ft high & wide.

#### Limelight Hydrangea

*Hydrangea paniculata 'Limelight'*

Soft green summer flowers change to pink in fall. Blooms every year. Soil pH does not affect bloom color. Matures at 6-7ft high & wide.

#### Little Lamb Hydrangea

*Hydrangea paniculata Little Lamb'*

Masses of pure white flowers begin flowering in mid to late summer. Blooms every year. Hardy. Excellent for fall and winter effect. Matures at 4-5ft high & wide.

#### Little Lime Hydrangea

*Hydrangea paniculata 'Jane'*

A dwarf selection of the Limelight. White flowers that take on a pink hue in Fall. Matures at 3-4ft high & wide.

### Annabelle Type ○●●

Annabelle types have large round blooms from midsummer to late fall. They prefer a moist but well drained location. They make excellent cut flowers. Prune dead wood in early spring.

## Seabuckthorn ○

This attractive small tree or shrub has narrow silver leaves. Plentiful round yellow orange fruits cover the female plants making them beautiful edible ornamentals. You need male plants to pollinate the female. The fruits are valued for their high content of vitamin C and anti antioxidants.

### Female

Bears heavy crops of medium size yellow orange fruit. Excellent juice. Highest Carotenoid content.

### Male

Required for fruit production. Large upright plant with narrow silvery green foliage which adds texture to landscape. 2-3 ft

### Golden Mock Orange

*Philadelphus coronarius 'Aureus'*  
Beautiful and versatile shrub featuring rich golden foliage and fragrant white flowers in early summer. Matures at 7ft high & wide.

## Honeysuckle ○

A tidy, ball-shaped and mounded shrub which features pale yellow flowers in spring and red berries in fall. Very hardy. Matures at 3ft high & 4ft wide.

### Center Glow Ninebark

Foliage starts bicoloured yellow-green and burgundy then settles to a distinctively rich red, which shows the white flower clusters very well. Matures at 6ft high & wide.

### Coppertina Ninebark

*Physocarpus opulifolius 'Mindia'*  
Has coppery-orange-red new foliage in spring that fades to a dark reddish-purple. White flowers. Matures at 7ft high & wide.

### Dart's Gold Ninebark

*Physocarpus opulifolius 'Dart's Gold'*  
Showy golden yellow foliage all season. White flowers in summer followed by red fruits. Matures at 5ft high & wide.

### Amber Jubilee Ninebark

*Physocarpus opulifolius 'Jefam'*  
Bright orange new foliage that darkens to green during the summer and turns purple in fall. Matures at 5-6 ft high & 4ft wide

### Tiny Wine Ninebark

*Physocarpus opulifolius 'SMPOTW'*  
Tiny deep purple foliage all season with clusters of pink to white flowers in summer. Matures at 3-4ft high & wide.

### Lemon Candy Ninebark

*Physocarpus opulifolius 'Podaras 3'*  
Bright golden foliage from spring to fall. White flowers in summer. Compact growth that matures at 3ft high and wide

### Burgundy Candy

*Physocarpus opulifolius 'Podaras 1'*  
Shiny Dark purple foliage. Larger leaf then summer wine. Matures at 3-4ft.

### Tiny Gold Ninebark

*Physocarpus opulifolius 'Tiny Gold'*  
Brilliant yellow new growth, small, refined foliage, and dozens of clusters of white-pink flowers in late spring. Grows 3-4ft

### Summerwine Black Ninebark

*Physocarpus opulifolius*  
The darkest purple black leaves, and dozens of clusters of white-pink flowers in late spring. Grows 5-6ft

### Ginger Wine Ninebark

*Physocarpus opulifolius 'Ginger'*  
Leaves emerge sunny orange and mature to burgundy and dozens of clusters of white-pink flowers in late spring. Grows 5-6ft

**Royal Jubilee Ninebark**  
*Physocarpus opulifolius 'Jefroy'*  
Deep dark purple leaves all summer and dozens of clusters of white-pink flowers in late spring. Grows 3-4ft

Potentilla flower from June to frost. They come in yellows, oranges, whites and pinks. Very hardy. Attracts butterflies and is deer resistant. Prune yearly. Zone 2.

### Coronation Triumph Potentilla

*Potentilla fruticosa* 'Coronation Triumph'

Bright yellow flowers. Matures at 4ft high & 3ft wide.

### Goldfinger Potentilla

*Potentilla fruticosa* 'Goldfinger'

Large golden yellow flowers. Matures at 3ft high & 4ft wide.

### Goldstar Potentilla

*Potentilla fruticosa* 'Goldstar'

Grey green foliage with large golden yellow. Matures at 3 ft high and 4ft wide.

### Yellow Gem Potentilla
